Day 23: Wagga Wagga—Home (BL)

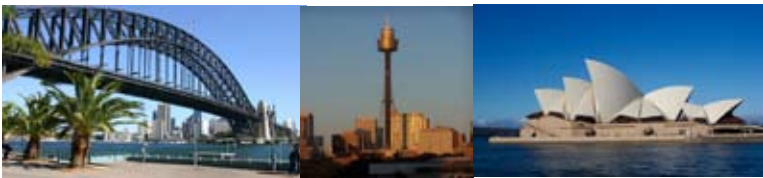
We will join the Hume Highway with lunch near Goulburn. We will drop off in Sydney and then en route to Thornton.

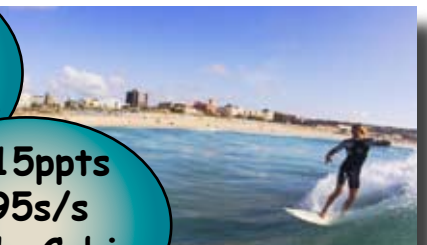
Day 1: Newcastle—Sydney: NSW Art Gallery, Pink Party (D)
