This morning we travel to Litchfield National Park to visit the beautiful **Florence Falls and Wangi Falls**, two of the many waterfalls cascading from the Tabletop Ranges.



You can enjoy a swim in the plunge pool at the base of the falls, or explore the surrounding monsoon rainforest. In the afternoon we leave the National Park via the small township of Batchelor and return to Darwin. Dinner tonight at your own expense giving you a chance to try the local restaurants.
