## Day 1: Home—Lord Howe Island (LD)

We will depart the Hunter south picking up enroute to Hornsby, before meeting the rest of our group at Sydney Airport. After lunch at the lodge, we will **cruise on a glass bottom boat** which operates within the island's sheltered crystal-clear lagoon. View from the comfort of the boat coral holes where stunningly beautiful reef fish and delicate coral formations abound. You can snorkel at Erscott's Hole or watch the unique double-header wrasse and other large reef fish being fed.

## Day 2: Half Day Tour of Island (BLD)

Today we will do a **half day guided bus tour of the island**. This tour will give us the opportunity to learn about the island's history and lifestyle, be introduced to flora and fauna and includes morning or afternoon tea. The group will be split in half to do the tour, and we will regroup for lunch at Pinetrees Lodge. The **other half of the day will be free** for you to explore your surroundings, or choose from one of the many options noted at day 5.



## Day 3: Lord Howe Nursery (BLD)

This morning we will visit **Lord Howe Island Nursery** for a tour. The nursery specialises in the Kentia Palm, an industry that has been going for over 100 years, which is vital to the economic development of the island. We will hear the story of this industry, its history and the market for these plants today.



## Day 4: Guided Walk & North Bay Cruise (BLD)

This morning we will enjoy a **guided walk** on the island on a **North Bay Adventure Cruise**, with its scenic journey up the lagoon, to pretty North Bay, where will enjoy a talk about the natural attractions in this area. Take some thongs as the 200-300 metre walk to Old Gulch is sometimes a little muddy. After morning tea at North Bay, we will **walk along a lovely beach** and perhaps a **guided reef snorkel** on the way home at the entrance to North Bay and see the remains of a wreck. For those who enjoy the activities, walk to the top of Mount Eliza (approximately 200m) with the best views of the island. We will have a **Barbecue lunch** at this beautiful part of the Island before returning to our lodge.



## Day 5: Explore the Island at you Leisure (BLD)

Today is your opportunity to play some **Tennis at the Lodge**, visit the **Island's Museum**, **organise some fishing, or diving, golf or bird watching, snorkelling, go hiking for the day, laze in the sun or just relax at your favourite spot**. The Museum Audio Visual Centre also has presentations on geology, birds, flora and fauna, history and marine life in the late afternoon on most days.

## Day 6: Lord Howe Island to Home (BL)

After lunch we will depart Lord Howe Island for Sydney Airport.

*Lord Howe has been awarded **World Heritage listing** for its rare collection of plants, birds, marine life and forsts, with spectacular Banyan trees and Kentia palms. The beaches and waters are pristine, surrounded by a marine park that includes a crystal clear lagoon, and the world's most southerly coral reef. **Limited to 400 visitors to the Island at any one time**, there are no crowds, the walks are world class from level strolls to the challenging climb to the peak of Mount Gower.*
